Objective of position: To reach out to women, men and families who are in a crisis pregnancy situation with the mercy and compassion of Jesus Christ by offering practical assistance in both word and action.

Reports to: Hope Pregnancy Center Director

Qualifications:

1. A commitment to Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.
2. An active, Bible-reading, praying, growing Christian and faithful member of a Bible-believing church and Bible study.
3. A belief in the sanctity of human life, forgiveness and salvation, and understanding of the Scriptures that pertain to it.
4. Full agreement with the HPC Statement of Faith and Statement of Commitment.
5. Dependable, stable, and capable of following through on commitments.
6. A sincere desire to reach out with compassion and the love of Jesus to people in distress.
7. No prejudice that would hinder working with clients of different races, creeds or religions.
8. Able to respect and keep confidentiality.
9. Completion of the approved volunteer training of this Center.
10. Committed not to be an activist while volunteering at the HPC.
11. Belief that the Scripture teaches sexual purity and abstinence outside marriage.

Training and Supervision:

1. Volunteer training as outlined by the HPC Director.
2. On-the-job orientation and observation before volunteering.
3. Volunteer meetings every quarter which will provide the opportunity to:
 - a. Pray with volunteers.
 - b. Fellowship with other volunteers.
 - c. Receive new information to increase expertise as a Volunteer.
 - d. Provide input.
