MINISTRY STORIES

CHILD-FOCUSED CARE

Oklahoma Baptist Homes for Children (OBHC) provides a safe, Christian environment where children are cared for by houseparents in a family setting. OBHC also offers Transitional Living to residents who have graduated high school and are continuing in some form of education.

Noah* comes from a family of eight siblings. He said it was a bit of an adjustment to move into a home with four other boys. “It’s definitely quieter here than at home,” he said.

“I think being here is a second chance at life,” said Noah. “I have a lot of opportunities here that I did not expect. This is a new beginning for me, and I am excited to see where it leads.”

FAMILY-FOCUSED CARE

Children’s Hope provides an opportunity to develop a solid foundation for single mothers and their children. The goal is to help these families become productive and self-sufficient by providing a safe, stable and nurturing place to live, while equipping them with important life skills.

Despite the fact she has been through numerous trials, Lisa* gives God the glory for how He has provided for her. Lisa said it was the goodness of God that led her to Baptist Children’s Home, Oklahoma City.

“God has been so good to me,” said Lisa. “Time and time again, he has provided for me. And I cannot thank the OKC campus enough for the impact it has had on me.”

HOPE PREGNANCY CENTER

The mission of Hope Pregnancy Center is to help young men and women have hope and choose life in the midst of an unplanned pregnancy.

Jennifer* became pregnant with her first child when she and Derek* were living with Derek’s mother. Neither of them had a job, and they did not know how

they were going to provide for their baby. They had heard great things about Hope Pregnancy Center and decided to attend classes at the center.

“Hope helped us learn how to care for our baby when we had no idea what we were doing. Because of Hope Pregnancy Center, we have accomplished keeping a home and maintaining a safe environment for our child,” Jennifer said.

ONE SUCH CHILD

One Such Child partners with local churches throughout Oklahoma to provide training and other events to encourage and equip foster and adoptive parents. Training opportunities are provided through live, in-person events and our online platform.




