CHILD-FOCUSED CARE

When Trent* arrived at Boys Ranch Town, he was leaving a difficult home environment marked by substance abuse. As he worked in the welding, leatherwork, and animal show programs, Trent developed leadership and became an example for younger boys. The greatest change came when he recognized his need for Christ, saying, “I needed Jesus because He saved me from my sin, my issues, my problems.” Through the love poured into this ministry, Trent’s heart—and his future—were transformed!

FAMILY-FOCUSED CARE

Homelessness brought Anna* and her 7-month-old son to Baptist Children’s Home (BCH), where she carried deep shame from a facial “demon” tattoo. With no means to remove it, God answered prayers through a nurse practitioner who removed it at no cost, while reminding Anna she is a child of God. Out of gratitude, Anna now saves money to purchase coats and blankets at resale shops, giving back to those still on the streets, just as she once was. Anna and her son are thriving at BCH because of your faithfulness in showing Christ’s love!

FOSTER CARE MINISTRIES

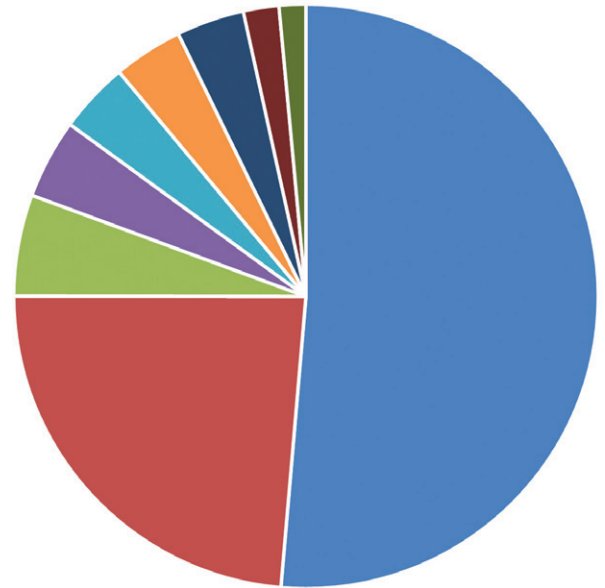

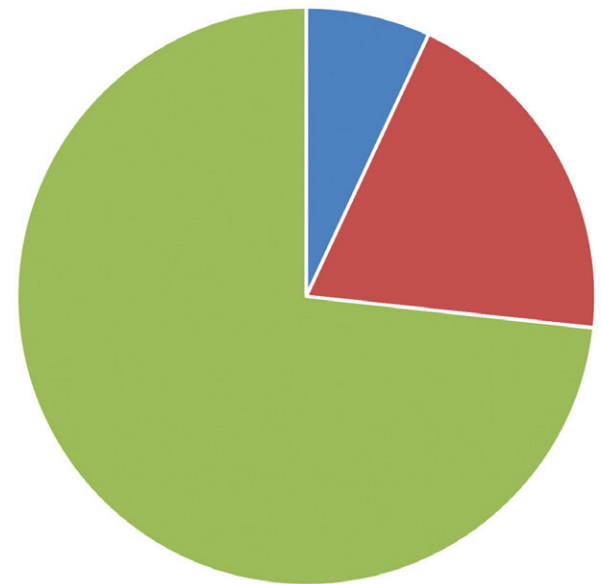
